QUESTIONS

- 13. MS. H. P. MANYENENG, MP. (MMOPANE-METSIMOTLHABE):** To ask the Minister of Transport and Infrastructure to state: **(348)**
- (i) if he is aware that there is no designated combi rank in the Mmopane–Metsimotlhabe area, resulting in combi and taxi operators operating from informal open spaces;
 - (ii) whether he is aware that the absence of basic facilities, including toilets, at these locations poses public health and safety risks; and
 - (iii) what steps he intends to take, in collaboration with the relevant Ministry to establish a formal combi rank with adequate facilities.
- 14. MR. G. DISHO, MP. (OKAVANGO EAST):** To ask the Minister of Lands and Agriculture to apprise this Honourable House on: **(401)**
- (i) why his Ministry continues to employ a significant number of workers on temporary or fixed term contracts, including renewals, despite the work they are hired for is of a continuous nature;
 - (ii) whether this practice is consistent with national labour laws and fair labour standards, and whether it does not undermine workers' rights to the job security, decent work and human dignity; and

- (iii) when his Ministry intends to review this practice and what concrete measures are being put in place to regularise the employment status of long serving temporary employees.
